Pennsylvania Auxiliary awards two (2) scholarships to a college in Pennsylvania.

REQUIREMENTS for these two (2) scholarships:

- A. To qualify for the first Department Scholarship, boy or girl must be a son, daughter, granddaughter, grandson of a deceased or totally disabled veteran of :

World War I – April 6, 1917 to November 11, 1918
World War II – December 7, 1941 to December 31, 1946
Korean War - June 25, 1950 to January 31, 1955
Vietnam Conflict – December 22, 1960 to May 7, 1975
Grenada/Lebanon – August 24, 1982 to July 31, 1984
Panama – December 20, 1989 to January 31, 1990
Persian Gulf War – August 1, 1990 to until cessation

A RESIDENT OF PENNSYLVANIA (this is important), a senior in an accredited high school in Pennsylvania and financially unable to continue his/her education.

- B. To qualify for the second Department Scholarship, the boy or girl must be a worthy son, daughter, granddaughter, grandson of a needy veteran (living) of World War I, World War II, Korean War, Vietnam Conflict, Grenada/Lebanon, Panama or Persian Gulf War. A RESIDENT OF PENNSYLVANIA (this is important), a senior in an accredited high school in Pennsylvania and financially unable to continue his/her education.

The value of these scholarships is \$600 per year – maximum time, four years, \$300 of which is payable at the beginning of the school year to a COLLEGE IN PENNSYLVANIA, and \$300 on January 1st, if she/he desires to continue in school and maintains the high standards of those qualities upon which they were selected. MAXIMUM TOTAL AWARD IS \$2,400.

A letter from the student should be sent to the Department Office before each semester, stating the date of the next payment and the name and address of the school treasurer. Also a copy of the grades should accompany the request.

APPLICANTS for Department Scholarship MUST SUBMIT
with their application the following:

- A. Name and address
- B. Photograph
- C. Branch of Service, parent or grandparent served in during World War I, World War II, Korean War, Vietnam Conflict, Grenada/Lebanon, Panama, or Persian Gulf War
- D. Four (4) letters of recommendations:
 - 1. One from the Principal of the high school from which applicant graduates,
 - 2. One from the Clergyman of the church the applicant attends
 - 3. Two from representative citizens certifying to applicant's character, Americanism, Leadership, Scholarship, and basis of need.
- E. Original article (essay) of not less than 400 words on a topic of his or her own selection, written by the applicant.
- F. Any additional data attesting to the applicant's qualifications as report grades, report of extra curricular activities and participation in civic activities, health certificate and name of State Educational Institution desirous of entering.
- G. Family record: Father, if living and employed, income. Mother, if living and employed, income. Number of brothers and sisters under the age of 18.

The candidate shall be selected on the following basis: Character, Americanism, Leadership, Scholarship, and basis of need.

All applications must be sent to the Department Chairman not later than March 15, 2010.
