BEST OVERALL VA&R PROGRAM BY A UNIT CHAIRMAN:

\$20.00 to the Unit VA&R Chairman reporting the best overall program in VA&R. The report must be typewritten in narrative form not to exceed 1,000 words. No pictures, clippings, scrapbooks, or folders are to be included. The name and address of the Unit Chairman must be included. Entry must reach Department Chairman no later than May 1, 2010.

MOST OUTSTANDING VOLUNTEER SERVICE BY A JUNIOR

MEMBER/VOLUNTEEN:

\$15.00 to the Junior Member/Volunteer with the most outstanding volunteer service in Hospital, Field or Home Service or combination of all. Junior Member/Volunteer must have accrued at least 50 hours of volunteer service. Volunteer hours have to be verified by the Unit VA&R Chairman or President. Entry must be submitted in narrative form not to exceed 500 words and must include name and address of the volunteer and the name and number of the Unit. Action photos are encouraged. Entry must reach Department Chairman no later than May 1, 2010.

VAVS REPRESENTATIVE RECRUITMENT OF REGULARLY SCHEDULED VOLUNTEERS AWARD:

\$20.00 to the VAVS Representative who recruited the greatest number of new regularly scheduled volunteers during the 2009-2010 administrative year of the American Legion Auxiliary. Recruited volunteers must have accrued a minimum of 20 volunteer hours during the year and may be either members of the American Legion Auxiliary, Non-affiliated volunteers or members of The American Legion or Sons of The American Legion. (Teens and student volunteers are ineligible.) Director of Hospital Volunteers must certify list. Entry must reach Department Chairman no later than May 1, 2010.

MOST OUTSTANDING HOME SERVICE PROGRAM BY A VOLUNTEER:

\$20.00 to the volunteer with the most outstanding Home Service (i.e. sewing, knitting, baking, cooking, crocheting, etc.) Entry must be in narrative form, not to exceed 500 words and must include the name and address of the volunteer as well as the Unit name, number and address. Entry must reach Department Chairman no later than May 1, 2010.
